David Boreanaz ([1]) es un actor, productor de televisión y director estadounidense conocido por interpretar los papeles del vampiro convertido en investigador privado Angel en The WB / UPN *Buffy the Vampire Slayer* sobrenatural . drama (1997-2003) y su spin-off *Angel* (1999-2004); la agente especial del FBI Seeley Booth , investigadora de homicidios, en la serie de comedia y drama de procedimientos criminales de televisión de Fox *Bones* (2005-2017); y Jason Hayes , operador principal de guerra especial de los SEAL de la Marina de los Estados Unidos, en la serie dramática militar *SEAL Team* de CBS (2017-presente). Boreanaz nació en Buffalo, Nueva York , donde su padre, Dave Roberts (nacido como David Thomas Boreanaz), trabajaba como meteorólogo y presentador de un programa infantil (*Rocketship 7*) como Dave Thomas, para WKDQ-TV, afiliada de ABC . Su madre, Patti Boreanaz, era agente de viajes. [2] Tiene dos hermanas mayores, Do y Beth. Es de ascendencia italiana y eslovena por parte de padre (el apellido Boreanaz es de origen esloveno). [3] [4] [5] Su madre es de ascendencia mitad eslovaca y mitad irlandesa, alemana, francesa y suiza. [6] [7] Cuando Boreanaz tenía siete años, la familia se mudó al área de Filadelfia , Pensilvania , después de que su padre aceptó un trabajo en WPVI-TV , la filial de ABC en Filadelfia. Boreanaz se crió como católico [8] y asistió a la Escuela Rosemont del Santo Niño en Rosemont, Pensilvania y luego a la escuela secundaria en la Escuela Preparatoria Malvern en Malvern, Pensilvania . [9] donde fue un atleta entusiasta y jugó en el equipo de fútbol de la escuela. [10] Se graduó de Ithaca College en Ithaca, Nueva York , en 1991 con una licenciatura en cine y fotografía. [11] Boreanaz se mudó a Los Angeles con un título en cine, pero inicialmente le resultó difícil conseguir trabajo como muchos otros actores con dificultades. Boreanaz dormía en un sofá que compartía en casa de su hermana, visitaba platós de rodaje y trabajaba como asistente de producción para aprender más sobre la industria en la que esperaba estar más involucrado. Fue un extra de fondo en la película *Aspen Extreme* de 1993 como un fanático que saludaba a los esquiadores. También preparó accesorios para *Best of the Best II* (también estrenada en 1993), protagonizada por Eric Roberts , donde también tuvo un pequeño papel sin acreditar; Se ve a Boreanaz de pie brevemente a la izquierda, mientras los personajes Tommy Lee y Alex ingresan a un club nocturno (que es la fachada de una red de peleas ilegales). [12] La primera aparición como actriz pagada de Boreanaz fue en 1993 como invitada en la comedia de situación estadounidense *Married... with Children* , como el infiel novio motociclista de Kelly , quien es golpeado por su padre. Al [13] Fue elegido para la serie de televisión *Buffy the Vampire Slayer* , después de que uno de los vecinos de Boreanaz le sugiriera el papel a Marti Noxon, después de que lo vieran paseando a su perro por su casa con regularidad. [14] En la serie de culto, interpretó al misterioso Ángel , un vampiro maldecido por los romances con un alma como castigo por asesinar a una niña romani, lo que inicialmente resultó en un remordimiento debilitante y luego en una vida de contrición. El programa tuvo un enorme éxito y Boreanaz protagonizó una serie derivada, *Angel* , que le dio al personaje la oportunidad de evolucionar y se concentró en la batalla de Ángel por la redención de los numerosos asesinos que comió antes de recuperar su alma. Apareció en *Buffy* de 1997 a 1999, momento en el que comenzó a protagonizar *Angel* , que duró hasta 2004, con un papel recurrente en *Buffy* después de su partida. También apareció en la película *Macabre Pair of Shorts* donde interpreta a la víctima de un vampiro (en el segmento "MPS"). El único papel protagonista de Boreanaz en una película teatral importante fue en la película de terror *slasher* *Valentine* de 2001 , junto a Denise Richards y Katherine Heigl . En 2002, tuvo un papel secundario en una película titulada *I'm with Lucy* . También iba a aparecer en la película *Resident Evil* de 2002 como el personaje principal, pero rechazó el papel. The 51-year old actor has been a part of a numerous hit TV series and is looking to add his latest venture to that list of wins. Unfortunately for those of you who may be nostalgic about his past on iconic shows like *Buffy the Vampire Slayer*, David Boreanaz doesn't want to look back. Sorry *Buffy* reboot fans, here's why he isn't interested in what you're interested in. SLOW START David Boreanaz's jump into an acting career was more of a stumble out of the blocks. While the acting bug came to him out of necessity, it took awhile for roles to find him. During an interview with *Parade*, David Boreanaz reflected back on when and why the itch began for him. "When I moved to Philadelphia, I got pushed around a lot and had to try to find my way. It was a different environment than Buffalo." Even more different was Boreanaz's move to Los Angeles. He would dress in a suit, pass out résumés around town and try to get himself onto different movie or TV sets. It worked when he found his way onto the *Cheers* set. "I looked like an extra, so I blended in and got lunch that day for free." But lunch didn't turn into a role. David Boreanaz first two roles were uncredited background gigs: one as a spectator and the other as a parking valet. His very first credited role came on the comedy series *Married... with Children*. It then took another three-plus years of kicking around Hollywood before the door would open again. **BUFFY THE VAMPIRE SLAYER'S ANGEL** According to David Boreanaz, it was the right place at the right time. As a true struggling actor, Boreanaz had been trying to make ends meet while deciding if acting was his true path. He told *Entertainment Weekly*, "When *Buffy* hit, I was in the right spot at the right time, but I had been struggling for years just to get in the door. I couldn't even do a commercial, like a gum commercial without freaking out. You have to go through the pain to get to the other end, and then once you get to the top, you're not down — you gotta climb other mountains. It's not like "Hey, let's pack it in." David Boreanaz looks back on his audition as fortuitous. "So I walked in, met with [casting director Marcia Shulman], read for the piece, then went back. When I met Marcia, we just connected. She is such a beautiful lady, someone who was in my camp. We talked a lot about the East Coast and New York restaurants and then got into this character, finally. Then, I went in the room and read for (executive producer Gail Berman), (creator Joss Whedon), and (co-executive producer at the time) David Greenwalt. They were kind of pressed against the hour to cast this character because I would have been shooting, I think, the next day. The day after they cast me, I remember being thrown into this world of complete chaos." After a long time being down and out, David Boreanaz nailed the role of Ángel. "It was all timing, really. [Angel] initially had an arc of 6 out of the 12 episodes. He was somebody who could be recurring and a love interest to Buffy (Sarah Michelle Gellar). It happened so quickly, but in order for things to happen quickly when you recognize them, you have to be ready; when it hits, it's quick." Not only did it hit quick, it hit big. Boreanaz was able to turn his *Buffy* role into his own starring vehicle in the spin-off series, *Angel*. **DAVID BOREANAZ GETS HIS OWN SPINOFF** As *Angel*, David Boreanaz was an immediate fan favorite. Co-creators Joss Whedon and David Greenwalt saw this and knew they had something. So while *Buffy the Vampire Slayer* was rolling, they put together the spin-off. *Angel*, too, was an immediate hit. Boreanaz's character moved out to Los Angeles to continue his vampiric ways. He would occasionally cross-over back to *Buffy the Vampire Slayer*, even appearing *Buffy*'s series finale, then spending one more season in his *Angel* attire. **BONES** With the massively successful run as *Angel* ending, Boreanaz was looking for more to do. It didn't take long as he had made a great name for himself in Hollywood. His next big, juicy role came shortly after the end of *Angel* with the hit TV series, the long-running *Bones*. As Seely Booth, he played the cocky, wise-ass FBI Special Agent partner to Emily Deschanel's Dr. Temperance "Bones" Brennan. You thought the *Buffy*/*Angel* relationship was something, but it didn't hold a candle to Booth and Bones. Theirs was a match made in heaven. It was so heavenly the series ran for 12 seasons with the pair appearing in each and every episode. While *Bones* was making a name for itself, Boreanaz found other projects around Hollywood. These ventured more toward the feature film arena as he starred in *The Hard Easy*, *Mr. Fix It*, *Suffering Man's Charity*, and *The Mighty Macs*. He also found time to do some voice work on *Family Guy* and *American Dad* while also appearing on TV shows such as *Full Circle* and *Sleepy Hollow*. **DAVID BOREANAZ IN CONTROVERSY** *Bones* was a huge hit for David Boreanaz, but there were some problems along the way. In 2011 actress Kristina Hagan sued David Boreanaz for sexual harassment she claimed she suffered on the set of *Bones*. Hagan accused the then 41 and married David Boreanaz of hitting on her while she was working on the show as an extra. She alleged that then later he texted her unsolicited photos of his penis. She further claimed that in an incident where David gave her a ride home he told her he was "the boss and that he "could make things happen for her" before pulling into a park and forcing himself on her. She claims he tried again later in his trailer. Boreanaz claimed the whole thing was absurd, but he later settled the lawsuit out of court. After that it all seemed to just go away with Hagan telling E! News "the matter has been resolved". **SEAL TEAM** You'd think that with the success of *Buffy* and *Angel*, then following that up with an extremely impressive run on *Bones*, that David Boreanaz best work was behind him. That would not be true. David wasn't sure what his next move was going to be after *Bones* ended. "I'm in a position now where I just don't feel like I need to chase anything in my life, so whatever happens, happens," he told *Parade*. *Seal Team* came quickly. Turns out, this role is the one he is most proud of. He said this about Jason Hayes, the Tier 1 *Seal Team* member he portrays, "He is really important to me and, playing him, I feel more in tune as I've ever been with a character." But it's not simply the character and how he's drawn up, but what he stands for and what the soldiers he portrays stand for. "We've gotten very positive feedback from veterans, Tier-One operators and armed forces people thanking us." T The goal for the series is to "shine light on these guys who suffer in what they do for a living and how they protect us." With that in mind, David Boreanaz pays homage to a real-life SEAL, one who was deployed on many a mission including the mission to take out Osama Bin Laden. "I wear his helmet. I could wear a lighter [prop] helmet, but I decided to wear his actual helmet to honor him and I will do that throughout the whole series of its run." It was this SEAL who brought the idea of the series to the network. **ARE WE GETTING AN ANGEL/BUFFY REUNION?** Don't ask about David Boreanaz going back to the world of *Buffy the Vampire Slayer*, because it ain't happening Okay, you can ask, but it still isn't happening. He's pretty adamant about it. What about David Boreanaz being part of a *Buffy* remake? He feels the new reboot is a good thing, he was pretty exact with his answer, "No, never; that's done, see ya, next. I have no problem with the cult audience, and I would totally get back into the genre, but I'm not a big reunion guy. I tend to like to go forward. I don't like to go backward—except when I've got ice skates on my feet and I'm playing hockey." **DAVID BOREANAZ NOW** Now 51-years-old, David Boreanaz is still the star of *SEAL Team* airing on CBS. He's still married to his second wife, Jaime Bergman, whom he married in 2001. They have two children together, a son born 2002 and a daughter born 2009. When not busy with work or family life, Boreanaz is still close friends with his *Bones* costar Emily Deschanel and he spends a lot of his time cheering for the Philadelphia Flyers. **MOVING ON, BUT NOT MOVING OUT** For the first four seasons, David Boreanaz's *SEAL Team* was a proud member of the CBS family. The hit series, which had ranked high on the most-watched CBS shows, is not leaving the CBS family, it is just moving over to the Paramount+ streaming service. The fifth season premiere was seen on the CBS network but has since made the move and remains a hit. "The streaming format allows us just to do more, more action, more intense scenes. It just gives us that extra fabric of getting deeper into the character development, and what these veterans and these characters struggle with, whether it's PTS (post-traumatic stress), or TBI (traumatic brain injury)." Mr. Boreanaz told *Entertainment Tonight*. But it's not only the move to Paramount+ or the fact that the show continues to pull in strong numbers or even the fact that Mr. Boreanaz gets to continue to tell the story of his Jason Hayes character that gets him revved up. No, it is also the fact that Mr. Boreanaz gets to sit in the director's chair again. His first directing gig came back in 2004 on an episode of *Angel*. After that, he put on his director's cap on a series he is very well known for - *Bones*. During the show's 12-year run, Boreanaz was behind the camera for 11 episodes. He took that experience with him to *SEAL Team*, where he directed six episodes. Mr. Boreanaz spoke highly of the new season and what fans will be seeing, which includes one of the latest episodes that found him behind the camera. "We'll be heading to Venezuela, doing a huge undercover op, which really will start to expose his brain issues and where they're at," he explained. "And one that I actually finished directing that is really gonna be intense as far as, you know, he could've really caused a major problem, which leads into the Venezuela hit, which is the end of season 4's run. But there's a really big arc with these characters, and that's gonna pay off nicely." Although there has been plenty of talk of a *Buffy*/*Angel* reunion, Mr. Boreanaz's focus is strictly on *SEAL Team*. Along with starring in the series and directing a few episodes, Mr. Boreanaz is also one of the series' producers. And what he loves most about being able to produce the show is how they continue to share stories of veterans who have been affected by mental health issues. "The veterans that are on our show, who have suffered from these particular illnesses and have struggled with mental health, that reflects on our show and that was one of the biggest things that Chris Chulack wanted to do when he did the pilot," he said. "And we've kept it real since day one and we're continuing to do that. It gives a good insight into what these characters are going through, and at the end, it can shed some light into some dark corners of people who are suffering out there. So that's our biggest reward." What a great reward to have. Telling stories and shedding light on the issues military veterans face can be very powerful. Hopefully, David Boreanaz and his *SEAL Team* crew have many more in them. And I guess we can always cross our fingers that the *Buffy* reunion happens at some point. It kind of needs to, right?
